If served out of the State of Arizona--whether by direct service, by registered or certified mail, or by publication--you shall appear and defend within 30 days after the service of the Summons and Complaint upon you is complete, exclusive of the date of service. Service by registered or certified mail without the State of Arizona is complete 30 days after the date of filing the receipt and affidavit of service with the Court. Service by publication is complete 30 days after the date of the first publication. Direct service is complete when made. Rule 4, Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure, and A.R.S. §§25- 311 to 25-381.22.
